

Launch of the Association of Information Security Professionals (AISP)'s AI Special Interest Group at the Inaugural AiSP AI Security Summit 2024

Singapore, 03 July 2024 – The Association of Information Security Professionals (AiSP) organised the Inaugural AiSP AI Security Summit 2024 as part of the AI Security Special Interest Group (SIG) with the theme of AI for Cybersecurity and Cybersecurity for AI at Marina Bay Sands Convention Centre. The event aims to focus on the innovative applications of AI in safeguarding digital asset and addressing the imperative of securing AI system themselves, tackling issues of adversarial attacks, data privacy and ethical consideration.

Dr Janil Puthucheary, Senior Minister of State for Communications and Information, is the Guest-of-Honour at this inaugural event. At the event, Dr Puthucheary addressed more than 100 guests from the industry, public sector and overseas information security associations during his opening address.

AiSP AI Security SIG Lead, Mr Tam Huynh shared, “Regardless of your optimistic or pessimistic view on the future of AI, the technology development and its application will continue to grow and significantly impact our work and life. It is important for all of us to stay updated on the technology, to learn to use its applications and shape its development for better outcomes.

It is hoped that the AI SIG of AiSP could be a platform where cybersecurity professionals can share interests in AI, learn from each other and share the knowledge with the community, for a better, and more secure world where AI would play a significant role”.
