## Three winners awarded the Prestigious Leader Award for the first time in the history of The Cybersecurity Awards 2024

Now in its seventh year, TCA 2024 made history by recognising three outstanding individuals in the Leader Award category for the first time. Mr Tan Kiat How, Senior Minister of State, Ministry of Digital Development and Information, will be the Guest-of-Honour for the event, and will present the awards to all nine winners.

#### b) <u>Leader</u>

#### Johnny Kho (Winner)
